## FR. BRAD BALDWIN MESSAGE

Greetings and Peace to my Brother Knights and your families, as we draw closer to the warmth of summer, and hopefully some time for rest and vacation. Speaking of drawing closer, I will soon be celebrating another anniversary of religious profession and ordination. Please keep me in your prayers, as I will continue to pray for all married couples celebrating anniversaries, and all who are celebrating significant milestones in their lives.

It is my own vocation story that reminds me of one very important theme, in our Christian lives. The beginning of my vocation discernment was filled with anxiety, confusion, and not really knowing what I was going to do, or what was happening to me. Fortunately, I had my family and my parish prayer group, who invited me to a conference at the Franciscan University of Steubenville. As Father Michael gave his talk about personal conversion, he said something that would change my life forever: "My brothers and sisters, Jesus Christ wants to come into your life. So, please give Him another chance, especially if you're apathetic about your faith, or if you're that thirty year old who has heard all this before, and believed that God could never welcome back a sinner like me. Please, please, give God another chance."

My Brother Knights, I was that apathetic thirty year old man, who needed to go to confession, be forgiven of my sins, and begin to once again be faithful to my daily prayer and Mass. This occurred in October of 1985, and two years later, I began my life as a Franciscan of the Third Order. So, after almost twenty- four years a Franciscan and nineteen years a priest, I've had many challenging moments, but have never looked back with regret, because I never forgot the second chance that God gave to me. Because of this, I try to remind others of the very same message: "Please don't give up on yourself, because God hasn't given up on you."

My Brother Knights, let this reminder not only help us, but encourage those we know who are struggling in their lives and their faith. During these days of summer, please take time for daily prayer, Mass, spiritual reading, and take time to thank God for all the second, third, and fourth chances that He has given you. Our best witness to others is that we remind them that we are living examples of God's forgiveness and unconditional love, and are always ready to say: "God has given me a second chance, and He will do the same for you."

Have a blessed month and a wonderful summer, and may we continue to pray for each other, for safe travel, and for all of our Brother Knights, family members, and friends who are sick or in distress. God bless you all, and until we speak again, I am: Your Faithful Friar, Father Brad.
