You can still call Ray Peterson to order and try one on. He has only one size XL but it will give a good idea of the size you may need.

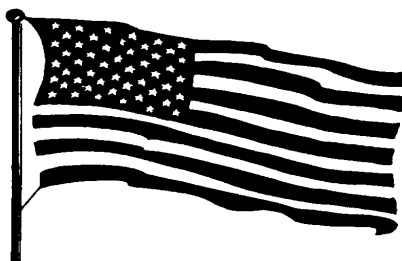
Below is sample of the vest style. The background color will be black and the printing will be gold or yellow. The emblem will be in color blue, red, white & gold.

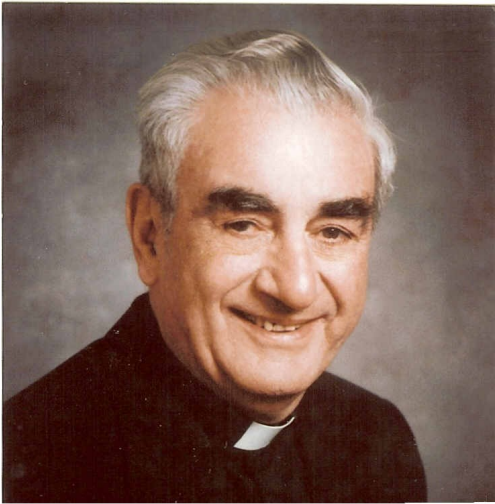

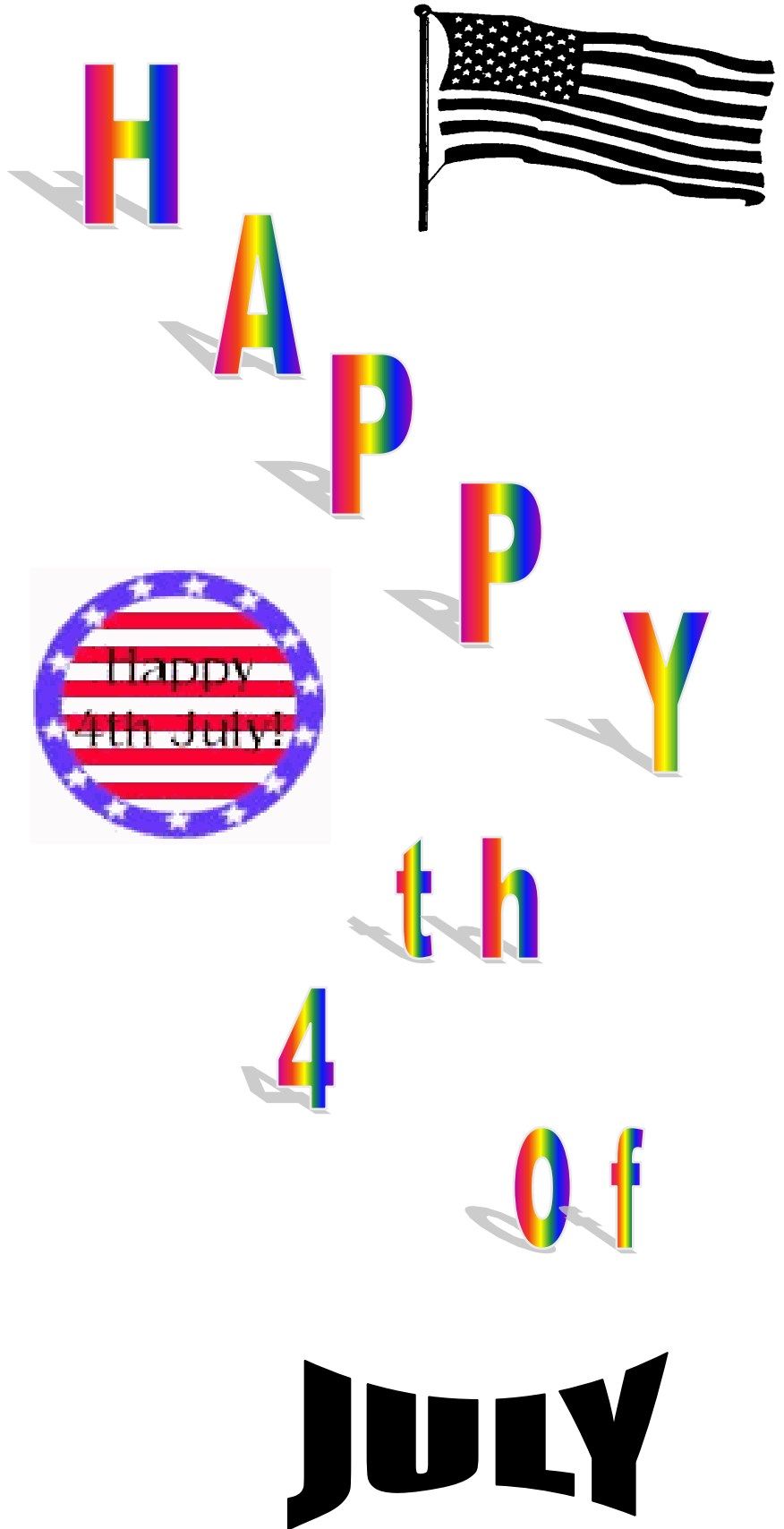
I want to thank each and every one of you that came and also those who could not make it, but prayed for me. May God bless you today and always.
